#### **AIRPORT**

The Catamaran Hotel is approximately 10 miles or 15 minutes from the San Diego International Airport at Lindberg Field. The Catamaran Resort Hotel uses Cloud 9 Super Shuttle. The cost is \$12.00 per person each way. Reservations are only needed when leaving the hotel for the airport.

#### **PARKING FEES**

The Catamaran Resort does charge \$13 per day for guest parking. We have a six-story covered parking structure as well as valet parking at \$17 per day as of January 1, 2008.

#### **ACCOMMODATIONS**

The Catamaran's 313 **San Diego hotel rooms** and suites are spacious and tastefully appointed with their own balcony or patio.
